

ScuttleBugs' Illness Policy

Certain symptoms in children may suggest the presence of a communicable disease. Therefore, to best protect the children in our care, those who have the following symptoms are required to be excluded from our program until they are symptom free for more than 24 hours without the use of medication. Should a child fall ill while at the center, he/she must be picked up from the center within 30 minutes.

Head Lice	First treatment is completed, no live lice are seen and ALL nits

Strep Throat/Scarlet Fever	24 hours after treatment begins AND child is without fever for 24
